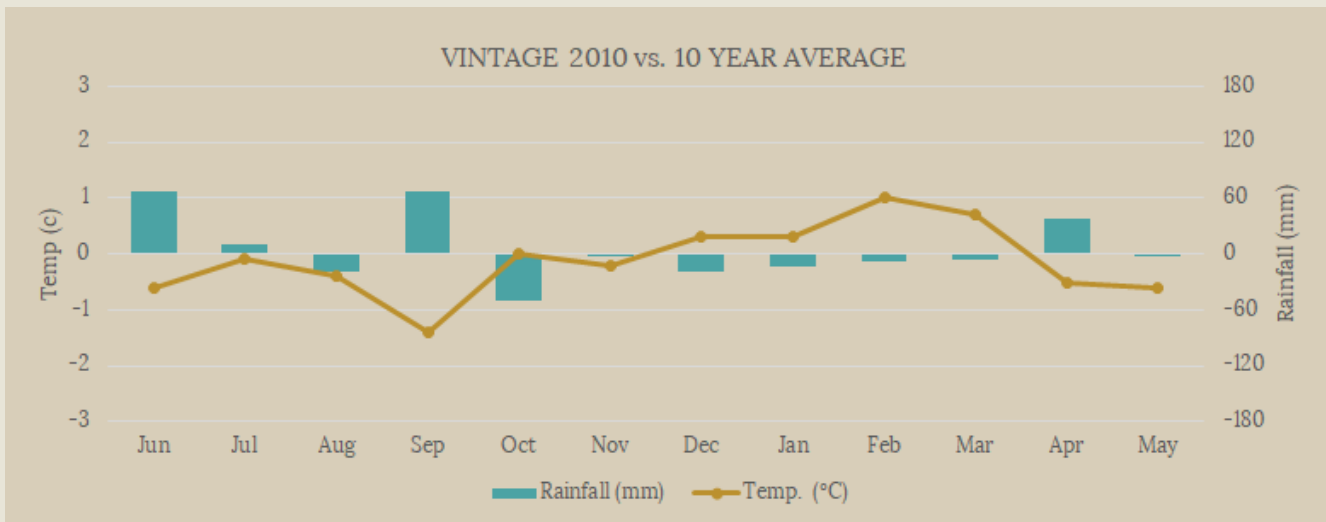


Growing Season

Conditions were cool for harvest, giving a slightly later and longer harvest period than usual.



The Wines

Chardonnay wines are showing intense melon and peach characters with plenty of fresh natural acidity. Red varieties deliver excellent wines that are very fruit driven and perhaps somewhat similar to the 2007 vintage.
