## **GIC makes interim determination Open for public comment until 13 March 2020**

The Margaret River Wine Association acknowledges the interim decision by the Geographical Indications Committee (GIC) which is responsible for determining Geographical Indications in relation to wine in Australia in accordance with section 40T and 40U of the Wine Australia Act 2013.

On Friday 6 December it was announced an interim decision has been made to recognise Wilyabrup as a separate geographical indication within the broader Margaret River wine region.

The interim determination will be published in national and state newspapers and the decision is open for public comment until 13 March 2020.

Submissions are then considered by the GIC prior to deciding whether to make a final determination of whether to enter Wilyabrup onto the Register of Geographical Indications.

During this period, the GIC welcomes the receipt of any scientific data or submissions that might assist to inform its deliberations.
